### BACKGROUND & RATIONALE

- Limited integration of environmental education in Zambia's early education system
- Youth unemployment and lack of green skill pathways
- National & continental alignment: ACQF and Agenda 2063
- Tourism and wildlife as untapped learning and employment platforms



#### PROJECT OVERVIEW

Launch: January 2023

Lead: Youth-driven, community-anchored initiative

Focus areas: Tourism, Wildlife, Environmental Sustainability Education

Model: Integrates theory + practice + leadership development





#### IMPLEMENTATION APPROACH

- 10 partner schools (primary & secondary)
- Collaboration with academic institutions, student associations & CSOs
- Curriculum integration (green literacy modules)
- Field learning: tree planting, recycling, eco-entrepreneurship
- Providing mentorship and training to environmental educators.

150+ trained youth educators

Reached 1,000+ pupils and community members

Activities: environmental clubs, recycling training, clean-



Leadership modules: civic engagement, policy

awareness, communication





## Measurable Impact





Our 2+ years OF TWESEP implementation looks like this:

2 Provinces reached (Lusaka and Copperbelt)

3 Districts reached (Lusaka, Kitwe and Chongwe)

15 Successful Capacity Building Master Classes Hosted

Reached out to 4 tertiary institutions

Over **150 students** have been trained as community educators

Trained 1000+ pupils in climate change education.
